- 4. Team members must be punctual to all meetings and ministry functions.
- 5. Team members must maintain good personal hygiene.
- 6. Team members must dress neatly and avoid sloppy or faddish clothing.
- 7. Team members must demonstrate kindness and Godly attitudes towards their fellow team members.
- 8. Team members must use the **King James Version** of the Bible when participating in group activities.

RMO uses the King James Version exclusively in the English language for ministry. We also recognize that believers hold a variety of views regarding the Bible-version issue, and we respect your right to read from whichever Bible version you choose.
